Dear Parents/ Carers,

Reception and Year 1 Christmas Performance Wednesday 4th December

We are writing to invite parents to come and join us as we celebrate Christmas here at Loxdale Primary School with our performance of *'The Grinch who stole Christmas'*. We will be holding two performances, one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

The morning performance will be for **Reception Willow and Year 1 Ash** parents/carers **only** and this performance will be taking place at **9:30am** with the children from these classes in the show.

The afternoon performance will be for **Reception Maple and Year 1 Elm** parents/carers **only**, this will be taking place at **2:30pm** with the children from these classes in the show.

We are allocating **4 free tickets** per family to the performance. This year, tickets will be issued per family via the Arbor app, we **will not** be allocating any further tickets after the initial distribution. This is a ticketed event due to limited space and fire regulations. **It is essential that parents/carers bring tickets to the performance-no one will be admitted without a ticket - EVEN BABIES.** Tickets will be sent out to parents on **Friday 29th November** via the Arbor app.

In this modern day, school is working with numerous blended families. We will be issuing tickets to the primary guardian named on your Arbor app. Please can we respectfully ask that tickets are shared initially between primary carers before being shared with wider family members and/or other partners to avoid any issues or upset. Throughout the year, each class also performs a class assembly where we do not limit the number of tickets for you to bring other family members if you wish.

Younger siblings (who do not attend Loxdale) **will** be allowed to our show. However, for them to attend, they will also be required to have a ticket, which will count as **one** of your allocated tickets. Please can we ask that, as our performers are young and only have small voices, you are mindful of the noise younger ones may make. Thank you for your support with this.

Please can we ask that you arrive with all of your party together, with the person who has been issued the tickets (primary guardian) with the in- app message ready to show members of staff. This will ensure a smooth start to our performance. Pushchairs/prams will not be permitted into the hall, babies and young children will need to be taken out of their pushchair to enter. Pushchairs will be stored safely.

We will be holding a small raffle on the door at each performance, if you are able to help and support us by purchasing a raffle ticket, we would be very grateful.
